**Board of Commissioners Meeting**

October 24, 2020

**Attendees:** Mayor Sanders, Commissioners Baugh, Brewington, Murchison, and Secundy. The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m.

**Citizen's Input**

There was a motion to approve the journal from September 2020 by Commissioner Baugh, a second and approval by all.

**Mayor's Reports**

Mayor Sanders reported that the Final Nuisance Flooding Plan has been approved by the state. There has been only one incident of Nuisance Flooding this year and one the year before.

Mayor Sanders has been attending the Four Rivers Coordinating River meeting on a quarterly basis. Four Rivers gives out many grants. It is expected that there will be grant funds this year. It was mentioned that work is being done to recognize the State of Maryland for Emancipation Day.

Mayor Sanders will request a report from the FDMCC for November's meeting.

**Commissioners' Reports**

Commissioner Brewington mentioned the request for lighting on Lake Avenue. BGE provided several options. BGE could install a wooded second pole at the cost of \$30.00 per month over the course of ten years. The second option would be a smaller light which would cost \$50.00 per month over the course of ten years. The third option would be to install a light with the homeowner managing the light. The homeowners can also install motion lights on their properties. It is felt that this would provide more

illumination. The spacing along the street is narrow. It needs to be determined if a pole could be installed and the next steps.

Commissioner Brewington mentioned that the trash can near the small pier is being used for poop deposit. The trash can will be removed as it was not placed there by the town. It has been asked if a small dog could be allowed on the beach. Commissioner Baugh is against this as well as Mayor Sanders.
