

HIGHLAND BEACH VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

A QUALIFIED VOTER MUST

- Be a U.S. citizen;
- Be at least 18 years old on or before the date of the next town election; and
- A legal resident of the town and registered to vote in Anne Arundel County or town elections, or
- Not a legal resident of the town but inhabits a dwelling in the town for at least sixty (60) days during the twenty-four (24) month period immediately preceding a town election and is registered to vote in that election. *sixty (60) days need not be consecutive

WHO MUST REGISTER

- Registration, at any time, with the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections by a qualified voter who has resided within the corporate limits is deemed registered for Town elections.
- Any person who is not registered to vote with the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections and who is qualified to vote may request to be registered or reregistered as a voter in town elections by written application to the Board of Supervisors of Elections. A person who registers to vote in an election as part of the town's supplemental registration is deemed a qualified voter for that election, and shall not be deemed a qualified voter in the next election unless that person reregisters.

DEADLINE INFORMATION

- The application must be received or postmarked no later than June 28, 2013, 30 days prior to July 27, 2013, the day of election.
- The submission of this form may be made in person to a member of the Board of Supervisors of Elections or by mail to 3243 Walnut Drive, Highland Beach, MD 21403.
- The application may not be emailed or faxed because an original signature is required
